- To not smoke, consume alcohol or drugs on or near the school property
- Inappropriate behaviour on the school site will not be tolerated e.g. displaying temper, shouting, using offensive language, threatening others, using physical punishment to correct your child's behaviour
- Not to send abusive or threatening messages or other communications to anyone within the school community
- Not to make offensive or derogatory comments regarding the school or any of the pupils/parents/staff at the school on Facebook or other social sites – any concerns you may have must be made through the appropriate channels by speaking to the class teacher, the Head Teacher or the Chair of Governors
- Must not use physical or verbal aggression towards another adult or child or use physical punishment against your own child on school premises
- Must not make racist or sexist comments

If this code of conduct is broken:

- We would first meet with the parent/carer and discuss the inappropriate behaviour
- If this did not resolve the issue then we would send a formal letter to the parent/carer and potentially invite the parent/carer for a formal meeting
- If the behaviour continued, we would send another letter explaining that the parent/behaviour would be banned from the school site.
