

children, developing crucial speaking and listening skills, promoting self-esteem
and self-confidence, a sense of group identity, togetherness and an opportunity
to develop skills, attitudes and attributes that can support learning throughou
the curriculum.

A high quality music education should engage and inspire pupils to develop a love of music and their talents as musicians, and so increase their self-confidence, creativity and sense of achievement. As pupils progress, they should evelop a critical engagement with music, allowing them to compose, and to listen with discrimination to music.












Music at Pinewood

Week 5= Fireflies- Owl City



We provide the children with as many experiences, visits and visitors as possible to promote good attitudes and a love of the arts.


